# A LETTER FROM THE VICAR



September brings with it the beginning of a new academic year and a new season. A new season in the life of many of our young people as they change schools or leave home to go to university or start work for the first time. A new season when typically the leaves begin to fall and the colour brown takes over from the colour

green as the signifier of the season (though many lawns are currently very brown!).

In the life of our local Church of England churches in Betley and Madeley we are also entering a new season. Early September will bring with it a number of changes. On 8 September (7:30pm at All Saints' Madeley) I will formally be 'installed and inducted' as Vicar after 20 months of being 'Priest-in-Charge to be known as Vicar'. The pandemic prevented this service from taking place earlier on in my tenure.

Installation and induction does make me think of when we had the vicarage oven installed, though I think there will be fewer boiler suits and more liturgical robes involved in this installation. In the same service we will also be celebrating with Rev Dot Woods who will be joining us as Associate Minister in Madeley and Betley. All being well, we'll also be formally commissioning Ruth Fish as our Children, Youth and Families Minister at the same service.

As the churches prepare to enter this new season of ministry, it is exciting to look forward to a new chapter of the shared life of our churches and to all the opportunities a new season will bring. Blessings,


Volunteers are the lifeblood of village activities and two organisations are looking for support in managing their finances – could you help the church (see below) or the Village Hall (page 22) in this way?



# **BETLEY, BALTERLEY & WRINEHILL PARISH COUNCIL**

**Congratulations to our local Surgery** 

The Parish Council, in thanking Dr Patel and his staff for their excellent work over the last two very difficult Covid years, would like to congratulate them on being in the top five Stoke-on-Trent and North Staffordshire GP surgeries (as ranked by their patients in a major survey). The Surgery was placed third, with 84% very good and 13% fairly good, only just behind second placed Honeywall Medical Practice, Stoke and well in front of the other two surgeries in the top five. Our community is very fortunate to have such an excellent medical practice on our doorstep along with its in-house dispensary.

#### How the Parish Council spends your money

Each year the Parish Council levies a precept which forms part of your overall Council Tax and is used to fund the Council's activities. Due to the size of the Parish and the precept, inevitably the range of activities the Parish Council can undertake is limited. In recent years funding has been withdrawn by both the County and the Borough so that the Parish Council has to fund more activities. Administrative costs are an overhead that has to be met to enable the Parish Council to carry out its statutory responsibilities.


This year the precept for a Band D property (on which the government bases Council Tax calculations) was £29.21 to the Parish Council, compared to £1,401.30 to the County, £210.24 to the Borough and £328.92 to the fire and police services. (The Parish Council proportion of the overall bill is approximately 1.5%.) The Council also expects to be able to reclaim £1,000 of VAT this year.

This gives the Parish Council an income of £18,204 against a planned expenditure of £18,225. The planned breakdown of spending for the current year is as follows (showing the amount per item and the annual cost per Band D household):

#### Notes:

- (1) The Clerk provides the Council with guidance on a wide range of subjects (procedure, finance, planning etc.) and is paid in accordance with national guidelines.
- (2) Includes the website, hall hire, insurance, audit etc.



- (3) Maintenance of the open space and the facilities provided.
- (4) General maintenance, twice-yearly planting of the flower beds and funding of Christmas tree, lighting etc.
- (5) Budget available for minor highways works (pavement clearing) and purchase and maintenance of speed monitoring equipment.
- (6) The main grant is toward the cost of maintaining the burial ground, a facility open to any resident of the parish.
- (7) Budget available for any projects which may be of benefit to the community.

The Council is subject to careful financial control including annual audit, and any underspend can be carried forward for future use. If you have any further questions regarding the Council's finances please do not hesitate to contact the Clerk or any of the councillors.

#### **Betley Court Farm Licence**

The application for a new premises licence for Betley Court Farm was considered by Newcastle Borough Council on 8 August. Licensing applications have to follow a prescribed format, with defined bands, and then conditions are developed and applied by the Licensing Committee, taking into account views expressed. The Parish Council is not a statutory consultee on licensing matters but it did ask the Licensing Committee to consider all representations made by residents (in objection or support) and it was represented for part of the meeting of the Licensing Committee.

The outcome of the meeting was that the licence was granted, but subject to a series of restrictions relating to the numbers permitted to attend, the number of events held, and the hours of operation. The Council hopes that the compromises made by the Speed family and the conditions agreed at the hearing will allow the business to prosper while protecting the interests and amenity of local residents. Our thanks to all local residents who contacted the Council on this matter or who attended the special meeting held in July.

### **Parish Council Meetings**

The next scheduled meeting of the council is at **7.30pm on Thursday 22 September** at the Village Hall The Council's meetings are open to the public (except for rare instances where confidential business is discussed and then the meeting will only be closed for that specific item) and local residents are welcome to attend. There is provision at meetings for public participation where you can comment on any agenda items.

#### Did You Know?

If you needed to pop out for a pint of milk, a pub might not be the first place you'd think of finding it, but in 1812 villagers could stock up on milk at The Black Horse Inn.

At that time, the Black Horse landlord was Charles Hedges, a former butler to George Tollet IV of Betley Hall. In June 1812, Tollet wrote that he had persuaded Hedges to start selling milk from the Hall farm (alongside ale) at The Black Horse for the benefit of the wider community.
